ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1. Application for admission must be made in the prescribed form available in the office.
- 2. Admission form along with Prospectus can be collected on remittance of requisite fee of Rs. 250/-
- 3. The duly filled application form shall be submitted to the office either in person or by post before the stipulated date.
- 4. Minimum eligibility criteria for application to the course shall be as per the state government norms.
- 5. Eligibility Criteria
 - For B.Com/B.A. Part I:
 - Minimum 45% of aggregate marks for B.Com. and B.A.in last qualifying exam (10+2) for students from Rajasthan / CBSE Board / any other equivalent Board
- 6. The process of admission will be strictly on the basis of merit. The weightage shall be given as per the State Government norms.
- 7. Students seeking admission in B.A. Part He will have to choose three optional papers from any one of the groups only mentioned above.
- 8. After 10 +2 or equivalent qualification a student not allow to admit in regular course having a gap of more than two regular academic sessions. Fulfilling that norm a regular/private student will be allowed to take admission in First year. He must provide an "Affidavit" declaring that he had not been associated with any of the college as regular/private student, during the gap years.
- 9. Candidates admitted to the college must deposit the requisite college fee at the respective Fee counter through one of the following ways:
 - Demand Draft / Pay Order of any Bank in favor of "Principal, S. S. Jain Subodh Commerce and Arts College" payable at Jaipur.
 - Online fee submission through Net Banking / Credit Card / Debit Card/UPI by link given on College website http://www.subodhcomartscollege.com
- 10. Respective documents must be duly attached with the admission form in order to avail the benefit of Sports, NCC, NSS, and Rovers.
- 11. In case of online fees deposition by the student, confirmation of admission shall be made only after the deposition of original documents and collection of the FEE RECEIPT by the student from the college office only.
- 12. A weightage of 3% will be given to Jain minority candidates in all courses at time of admission. If the candidate has claimed more than one weightage then only one highest weightage will be given.
- 13. Decision taken by the admission committee will be treated as final. All the disputes are subject to Jaipur Jurisdiction only.

Note: Office Timings of the college will be 11:00 AM – 04:00 PM (Monday to Saturday).

Right of Rejection / Denial of Admission

- 1. Director / Principal has the right to reject the admission under following circumstances :
 - In case the applicant has hidden any related fact willingly.
- In case the applicant has not deposited application form and fees within the stipulated time or he has submitted the incomplete form.
- In case the candidate does not fulfill the admission norms of University of Rajasthan.
- In case the applicant was punished for using unfair means during his board exams.
- In case he has been corrupted/misbehaved during the period of his board with any member of the institution.
- In case the applicant indulged in the use of unfair means like bribery or terror in order to take admission in college.
- In case of non-availability of seat.
- 2. Admission shall not be given to those students who want admission in the same class for the purpose of improvement of marks.
- 3. Applicants appearing for supplementary exam, can take admission in the next class within the given time period.
- 4. The eligibility of a candidate is ascertain on the basis of the minimum passing marks, instead of the marks obtained in the paper/subject
 - of supplementary exam shall be taken into consideration.
- 5. Based on the above rules if a candidate has been admitted as a regular student, but has failed in the supplementary exams, then his regular admission will be automatically cancelled.
- 6. The regular students, who are eligible for Part II & Part III must fill their re-admission forms and deposit requisite fee, within 15 days from the date of declaration of the result, otherwise they may be denied admission in the course.

Rules & Regulations

- 1. Director / Principal have the right to do amendments in the rules published in prospectus.
- 2. Changes if any, in the syllabus by the University of Rajasthan will be applicable as such.
- 3. Students, taking admission for the first time in the university, must submit duly filled enrollment form along with the examination form in order to get themselves enrolled in University of Rajasthan. Information related to enrollment and examination will be displayed on the notice board.
- 4. No change will be made once the optional subject is allotted to a student. Director/ Principal have the right to allow for any changes in the allotment of subject within 15 days of admission only in unfavorable condition.
- 5. Students themselves shall be responsible for the attendance record. Teachers will keep their respective students updated about the attendance at the end of every month. Students, failing to stand the 75% of attendance (as per the norms of University of Rajasthan), have to appear in examination as non-collegiate candidate.
- 6. Students whose result is declared late by the University, attendance will be counted from the 10th day of result declaration or admission date whichever is earlier. No relaxation will be entertained for attendance in any circumstances. If anyone is found guilty towards his academics, no relaxation will be given for attendance.
- 7. Relaxation in attendance for the students participating in sports or academic activities will be considered only when they fall short of it. Otherwise, not any such case will be considered.
- 8. Students can take part only in one of these activities i.e. Games / NSS/NCC/ Rovers.
- 9. Class arrangements for Arts and Commerce students have been made for both Hindi and English medium.
- 10. Academic evaluation of students: "Term Tests" are conducted in order to make students familiar with examination pattern and to develop their answering skills. Faculty members evaluate the answer sheets and try to make betterment in the student's performance. Parents / Guardians are regularly informed about the progress of their ward.
- 11. The entry in the college premises is only by the college identity card. Therefore, every student should wear identity -card daily in neck so that it is visible to all.
- 12. Parents / Guardians should timely keep themselves informed about the progress of their ward. They can communicate with the concerned head and related faculty members.
- 13. Parents / Guardians will be responsible for the character, behavior and due fee of their ward.
- 14. The college provides concessions in bus or railway fare only on the occasion of long vacations. In order to avail this facility student must submit application in the office before three days.
- 15. Bus / Railway concession is granted on the basis of permanent address.
- 16. Students must park their vehicle in the parking zone and get the receipt of token fee. Their vehicles must have the registration number in order to avoid any inconvenience. Student himself will be responsible if he parks his vehicle on other than the allotted parking area. Four wheelers of the students are not allowed in the college campus.



Discipline & Code of Conduct

The aim of the college is teaching and research. Inherent in this aim is the responsibility of the college to educate its students to be a responsible citizen. College students must carry a good character and behavior so that they can be the role model of the college. The code of conduct of student outlines the student's behavior and disciplinary guidelines that must pertain to him at college. Any student found responsible for the violation of any clause outlined in this section is subject to disciplinary action. In order to maintain the dignity of Subodh, all the students must follow/adhere to the rules strictly.

Following are the rules and regulations which act as guidelines for the students

- 1. Any change in contact details of the student/ parent/ guardian or home address should be notified to college office.
- 2. Every student must attend all the classes regularly and wear his identity-card.
- 3. As per Supreme Court verdict, Ragging is a punishable offence and therefore such activities are strictly prohibited for the college students in or outside the campus. FIR will be registered against such students who are found involved in ragging or other similar activities.
- 4. Smoking, chewing tobacco, liquor consumption etc. are strictly prohibited. If any student is found involved in aforesaid activities. Then action must be taken against him.
- 5. Use of mobile phones is strictly restricted within the college campus.
- 6. Unruly behavior, offensive gestures, usage of slang and abusive language will be counted in the jurisdiction of misconduct. Any such activities or behaviors are prohibited by the college authority and are a punishable act.
- 7. Damage, defacement, or destruction of college property in any of the form will be a punishable offence.
- 8. Noise or unwanted clamor that disrupts the academic environment shall not be acceptable and in case of violation, strict disciplinary action will be taken.
- 9. Marking of proxy attendance is a punishable act.
 The Code of Conduct cannot assure all eventualities, so we should use our common sense, and be responsible for your actions.

STUDENT ELECTION

S. S. Jain Subodh Commerce and Arts College is entirely a private college and believes in imparting quality education. So, any kind of student's politics or unnecessary interference and alliance of the political issues is strictly prohibited in the college premises. From the session 2015-16 and onwards, the Student Union has been dissolved and since then, no student elections are conducted. No student shall demand for the student elections.

IMPORTANT NOTE

All the college students should abide by traffic rules and must careful while crossing the Rambagh Circle or nearby college campus area. The college shall not be responsible in case of any mishap due to traffic rules violation by students.

Rules & Regulations of Fee

- 1. Timely deposition of fee is mandatory.
- 2. If the student is unable to pay the fee, his name shall automatically be removed from the college. The student shall deposit the fee online on college website http://www.subodhcomartscollege.com/ or pay by Demand draft or pay order in favor of "Principal, S. S. Jain Subodh Commerce and Arts College, Jaipur".
- 3. Students are strictly advised to deposit their fee at the authorized counter of the cashier through Demand Draft/Pay Order (to be deposited in HDFC Bank) and collect the receipt of the same. It is for the information of the student that only authorized person is responsible to collect the fee, on behalf of the college administration, no one else.
- 4. Fee once deposited shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 5. Student shall pay the fee for the entire session, irrespective of the fact whether; admission is being taken in the beginning or mid-session.
- 6. At the time of admission, student shall pay the entire annual fee.
- 7. The information regarding university examination fee will be displayed on the notice board timely. Students are required to deposit the fee with the examination form before the last date declared by the university. The college will not be responsible for any lapse on the part of student regarding to apply and submission of University examination form.
- 8. Meritorious and talented students will also be entitled for free-ship and textbooks, in case they apply for the same.
- 9. Meritorious but financially weak students will be entitled for relaxation in tuition fee. No other relaxation will be granted. Financial assistance will be made available from "Students Assistance Fund".

 Those who wish to take assistance from this fund may also apply on prescribed application form in the month of December. Relaxation will be granted by the free-ship committee.
- 10. The caution money will be returned in next session only through account payee cheque only.

 If the student does not collect his caution money within a year, the money will be transfer to Student Alumni Fund. The application form for refund of caution money can be collected in the month of December of forthcoming session.

Library: The Knowledge Centre

A one stop destination for books and useful resources providing information with easy access is called a Library. Libraries are treasure troves of knowledge. A gateway to learning and way of life, library performs a vital part in making society meaningful. The sources and services it provides a chance for new learning and facilitate to create the innovative thoughts and perceptions that are decisive to an inspired and enthusiastic society. With this ideology, S.S. Jain Subodh Commerce and Arts College has good number of quality books to up-grade the student's knowledge and widen their wisdom. The college library is filled with a vast & comprehensive collection of more than 22494 books covering all aspects of academic material. It subscribes 10 newspapers in Hindi and English language and 9 magazines. The well-equipped reference section of the library has a rich collection of encyclopedias, dictionaries, vishwakosh, Journals and reference books. The college facilitates the students, whose guardian's annual income is less than 200000/-by lending books from the Book Bank section. Also the college provides this facility to meritorious students. The student can take only two books at a time and should return it back to the library within 14 days without any wear and tear. Comfortable & serene sitting area, water cooler, drinking water purifier, wash room, proper light and ventilation are some other basic amenities provided to the students. The college library has a computerized system for entry and issuing of the books. This helps and supports the staff to work more systemically & effectively.


